



Fellow Cardiac Electrophysiology

We are inviting applications for a one-year fixed term position as Fellow in Cardiac Electrophysiology at Auckland City Hospital starting in early January 2010.

The fellowship is designed to give in-depth experience to a trainee intending to specialize in Electrophysiology and Device Therapies.

The EP Service at Auckland City Hospital includes both Adult and Paediatric EP with 3 Interventional Adult and 1 Paediatric Electrophysiologists.

Approximately 300 ablation procedures are performed per year. 3D Mapping facilities include ESI and CARTO. A high volume of device therapies include approximately 500 pacemaker implantations and 150 – 200 ICD implantations per year.

You are expected to have had some preliminary experience in Electrophysiology and to be competent in percutaneous access. While primarily a clinical training position, some research and audit activities will be encouraged and supported. In addition to Lab Commitments, you will participate in some undergraduate EP based teaching, and Outpatient Clinic sessions. Subject to negotiation, limited call responsibility would be anticipated.

You must be eligible for registration with the Medical Council of New Zealand. More information about Medical Registration is available at their website: www.mcnz.org.nz
