We are seeking a Neonatal Fellow, commencing Dec 2009 or early 2010. The post is suitable for experienced trainees in paediatrics who wish to pursue a career in neonatal medicine or trainees in general paediatrics with an interest in neonatology. The contract is for an initial term of 12 months, but is extendable for another year by mutual agreement.

The role involves a mixture of clinical research, teaching and clinical work, including participation in the resident roster. Research time is protected and fellows are expected to develop their own research projects as well as participate in existing studies. Fellows can develop skills in echocardiography and are able to participate in neonatal transports.

Newborn Services have been accredited by the Royal Australasian College of Physicians for training in Perinatal-Neonatal Medicine. The Newborn Services have 46 infant cots (16 Level 3 cots) and is the regional Level 3 neonatal centre for 3 local Level 2 units. The NICU also acts as a regional surgical NICU, and there is close liaison with national paediatric cardiology services.
